Sir,

It is stated that the assessment report (May, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at P.E.S. Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam for purpose of Recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to 06(Six) seat(s) granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. was considered by the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 22.08.2013 and it was decided as under:

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2013) and noted that MS(General Surgery) qualification is already recognized with 04(Four) seat(s) and decided to recommend that MS(General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to 06(Six) seat(s) granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. in respect of students being trained at P.E.S. Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 with the number of admissions to 06(Six) student(s) per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause 4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
